# Abstracts are invited for 1st Obs & Gynae update 2025

Abstracts should be submitted in the following format

- Presenting Author: (Surname, Initials, bold and underline) affiliation details (designation, name of institution, city), email and phone number. Co-authors: (Surname initials)
- Title: It should be short and indicative of the research paper.
- The abstract should have an Introduction, Aims and Objectives, Materials and method, Results and Conclusion (total no. of words should not exceed 300),
- In case report Introduction, Case history, Discussion (discuss rationale for decisions that were made and the lesson from the case), Conclusion (total no. of words should not exceed 250)
- Font size standard Times New Roman 12, single line spacing. Use only standard abbreviations. Place special or unusual abbreviations in parentheses after the full word appearfirst time.

The abstract should be in MS Word file. Paper should be original and authentic work of author and it should not have been presented in any forum or published in any journal/media. Only one abstract will be accepted per presenting author.

All abstracts submitted as case report will be eligible for poster presentation only.

The abstracts submitted as case series will be reviewed by scientific committee for oral or poster presentation and informed accordingly to the presenting author.

The last date for submission is 15/10/2025

**Paper presentation:** The time allotted for paper presentation is 5 minutes followed by 2 minutes of question answer session. The presentation should be in MS-Power point 16:9 layout in PPT format.

**Poster presentation:** The dimensions of the poster panel in portrait format are 90 cm wide x120 cm high.

**Quiz guidelines:** One team of two residents per institution is allowed. **Last date for confirmation of participation in quiz is 25th October 2025.** 

**Award category:** 1st, 2nd and 3rd cash prizes in junior resident category and senior category each would be given for paper and poster. Top three teams would be awarded cash prizes in Quiz.

#### **NAINITAL** (Distance from Bareilly - 130 km)

Situated admist Kumaon Hills and blessed with beautiful lakes Nainital has earned the epithet of "Lake district of India". It is known as paradise for tourists because of its beautiful landscape and serene surroundings.

#### **RANIKHET** (Distance from Bareilly - 170 km)

Ranikhet, widely known as "Queen's Meadow" is a scenic hill station of Almora district. According to folklore, Queen Padmini of Kumaon region once visited the town. The places to visit are Jhula Devi Temple, Binsar Mahadev, Kumaon Regimental Centre Museum and Memorial.
